Using your Internet connection, the MX-LIW automatically retrieves weather information via Ethernet (TCP/IP) from the National Oceanographic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) website and displays that information on your in-store channel. Internet weather, along with your own local information, helps ensure that your channel grabs viewers' attention to get the word out - AND IT ALL HAPPENS AUTOMATICALLY!
